COMMUNICATIONS

This manual supplement prescribes additional procedures in effect for all Wisconsin Wing CAP units. Full understanding of this supplement may only be obtained by reading it in conjunction with the related paragraphs of CAPM 100-1, Volume 1.

CAPM 100-1, Volume 1, 1 August 1996 is supplemented as follows:

5-1. Requirements for Operating a CAP Radio Station. All squadron and flight communications officers are designated qualified trainers for communications orientation classes.

5-2. Certification. Unit commanders, upon certification by the unit communications officer, will issue CAP Form 76, Radio Operator Authorization, to qualified members of his/her unit.

5-3. Advanced Communications User Training. All squadron and flight communications officers are designated qualified trainers for advanced communications user training.
