**ACQUIRING AND ACCOUNTING FOR REAL ESTATE AND FACILITIES
FOR CIVIL AIR PATROL**

This regulation supplement prescribes additional procedures in effect for all Wisconsin Wing CAP units. Full understanding of this supplement may only be obtained by reading it in conjunction with the related paragraphs of CAPR 87-1.

CAPR 87-1, 1 January 1989 is supplemented as follows:

5. CAP Real Property Survey. Each squadron and flight will send to Wing Headquarters/LGR a copy of the unit's Real Property Survey Form (CAPR 87-1, Attachment 3) whenever the information on that form changes. Also, by 30 January of each year, each squadron and flight will send to WILGR either a copy of the unit's Real Property Survey Form or the following statement dated and signed by the squadron commander: "I certify that all information on the CAP Real Property Survey dated _____ is accurate and current."
