Arrival, Transportation, and Pick-up

Arrival: Students arrive by 1900 hours on Friday evening. You will check in at Building 475.

Transportation: Transportation to/from Volk Field is the responsibility of the member. You should check with your home squadron to see if they are coordinating transport to/from the event. Members who will arrive later than 1900 should please email Lt Col Risler at Joshua.Risler@wicap.us.

Pick-up: Pick-up can occur at 1230 hours on Sunday. Parents who are picking up their cadet from Volk Field Need to fill out the security form or contact Lt Col Risler at Joshua.Risler@wicap.us to pick up your cadet at the main gate to Volk Field. We will transport your cadet out to you as you will not be allowed to go past the front gate area unless you have a valid CAC, DBIDS, or retired military ID card.

Meals & Lodging

Lodging will be in dormitories. Assignments will be provided at check in. Linens, blankets, and pillows will be provided (**we are not providing towels so please pack one**). We will provide the following meals: Saturday breakfast, lunch, and dinner and Sunday breakfast. If you have special dietary needs or food allergies, **please let me know immediately and update your CAP health.**

Packing lists follow on the next two pages – note they are different depending on your school. We cannot stress strongly enough the need for warm outerwear. Each year some number of cadets arrive without jackets, hats, or gloves. Much of the weekend is spent working on drill outdoors in mid-November in Wisconsin. Please help your cadet be successful by ensuring they bring jackets, hats, gloves, and warm socks for their boots.

Airman Training School Packing List

- Uniforms:
 - Blues uniform: Short Sleeve Blue Shirt, Blue Pants, Blue belt with nickel tip and buckle, Flight Cap with Cadet Enlisted Insignia, Nameplate, Ribbons, black dress shoes, white V-neck t-shirt, black crew length socks
 - Airman Battle Uniform: ABU blouse, ABU pants, tan rigger belt, black combat boots, blousing bands, ABU hat
 - Cadets who do not yet have a uniform or do not have complete uniforms as listed above: Black t-shirt with no printing, Khaki pants. Note that if you do not own khaki pants you can substitute blue jeans in good condition. If you do not have black t-shirts without printing you may substitute a squadron t-shirt if you have that. **Please wear shoes that are good for drill and for being outside.**
- Civilian attire and Undergarments
- PT Gear – Running/Sweatpants, Sweatshirt, t-shirt, running shoes
- Rain poncho
- Toiletries
- **Bath towel – towels will NOT be provided**
- Notebook, pen, paper. Phones are allowed.
- **Outerwear – this is a critical item as we will be outside. This includes an appropriate jacket, hat, and gloves.**
